9.	Description of training post	The first part of the post will be based in DGRI from September 2024 through to March 2025. There is supervised training in theatre and outpatients, in both OMFS
	training post	and Oral Surgery. General outpatient clinics see referrals from dental and medical
		practitioners, as well as the community and hospital services. There are combined
		clinics in head and neck cancer and access to further multidisciplinary clinics.
		These reflect the multidisciplinary working practice within the region. Involvement is









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		encouraged in the management of these patients. There is good exposure to minor Oral Surgery. There is no out of hours on call for DCTs.		
		The DCT1 will undertake a range of PDS duties from March 2025 to August 2025. Predominantly this will involve the provision of comprehensive dental care for registered paediatric and adult patients with additional needs as well as assessment and treatment of referred patients including management of dental anxiety. The DCT1 will also attend regular Special Care/exodontia theatre sessions and will receive training and experience with inhalation sedation for both children and adults as well as participation in intravenous sedation clinics. The post will also include regular domiciliary dental visits and there will be opportunities to attend prison dental clinics, dental inspections of schoolchildren and both Outreach dental student and therapy student teaching clinics. In addition, there will also be the requirement to provide some emergency dental care for unregistered patients within the region with the option of participating in additional paid out of hours sessions in evenings and at weekends. Please note accommodation is provided free of charge within NHS hospital residences for this post.
