		The Department of Oral Medicine receives referrals from a wide geographical area as it provides the main specialty referral centre for the West of Scotland and beyond. The specialty manages patients with non-surgical head and neck problems encompassing a wide variety of medical specialties. Core training post holders are allocated to consultant clinics where they will see patients under supervision. Most clinical activity takes place at the Glasgow Dental Hospital —however the DCTs will be expected to travel if required to clinics out-with GDH. Virtual clinics are also undertaken via video (Near me) or telephone. There is a phlebotomy service supported by trained dental nurses. The DCT's in Oral Medicine are expected to screen laboratory results and help prepare cases for clinico-pathology meetings, complex case discussions and morbidity and mortality meetings. In addition, the DCTs will embark on QIP projects with the help of senior colleagues. There are 3 rotational Oral Medicine StR's and there are many learning opportunities for DCT's including presentations at journal clubs. All departments in this post have been extensively refurbished in recent years and offer excellent clinical facilities.

13.	Educational programme summary	There is a Scotland-wide education programme for Dental Core Trainees which is designed to match the DCT curriculum. The programme has four themes running through each year of Dental Core Training. These are: Clinical, Communication, Career Development Skills and Quality Improvement & Patient Safety. Posts begin with a local health board and NES induction, followed by face-to-face study events throughout the year, supported by Turas Learn. These events include all Dental Core Trainees in Scotland, as does the annual DCT conference. All trainees have access to study leave time (in line with terms and conditions of
