

## Accessibility Factsheet Frankland Building (DDEC)



Level access to the building. (Level approach and step-free)








Sloped access to the building. (Step-free with ramps)







Entrance doors to the building are automatic. (Including the use of a "push to open" button)








Approach or entrance has more than three steps.







Internal doors are automatic.







Internal corridors are step-free.







There are lifts to access different levels.







On-site parking. The venue has its own or shared car park.







Off-site parking. There is a public car park or street parking within 200m.







There are blue badge/ accessible parking bays in the car park or on the street.







There is a designated drop-off point within 200m of the venue.







There are accessible toilets with step-free access.







There are standard toilets with step-free access.







There are accessible shower/ changing facilities.







There are standard shower/ changing facilities.







Stoma friendly toilet available. This includes a hook for hanging clothing and belongings, a shelf (minimum dimensions 125mm x 400mm) a full length mirror, a disposal bin within the cubicle, and 'Not All Disabilities Are Visible' signage.







There are members of staff trained in sign language.







Assistive listening/hearing enhancement system available.







Information in large print (font size 16+) is available.







Information in braille is readily available.







Staff have received disability awareness and/or equality training.







There is a designated safe or quiet space.







Facilities for assistance dogs are available (upon request).
