Role and Remit

1. Remit

Membership of Electronic Reference Group for the Effective Practitioner Initiative will require active participation but the extent of this will be dependant on members own capacity and area of expertise.

The remit of the Electronic Reference Group is to support the development of the Effective Practitioner Initiative for NHS Scotland:

- During 2010-2011 the Group will be invited to provide an opinion on the effectiveness of tools and learning resources which are being developed as part of the initiative.
- During 2011-2012 the Group will be invited to provide an opinion on how the tools and resources can be most effectively used within practice.
- The Group will be expected to act as ambassadors for the initiative within their own sphere of influence.

2. Stakeholder representation

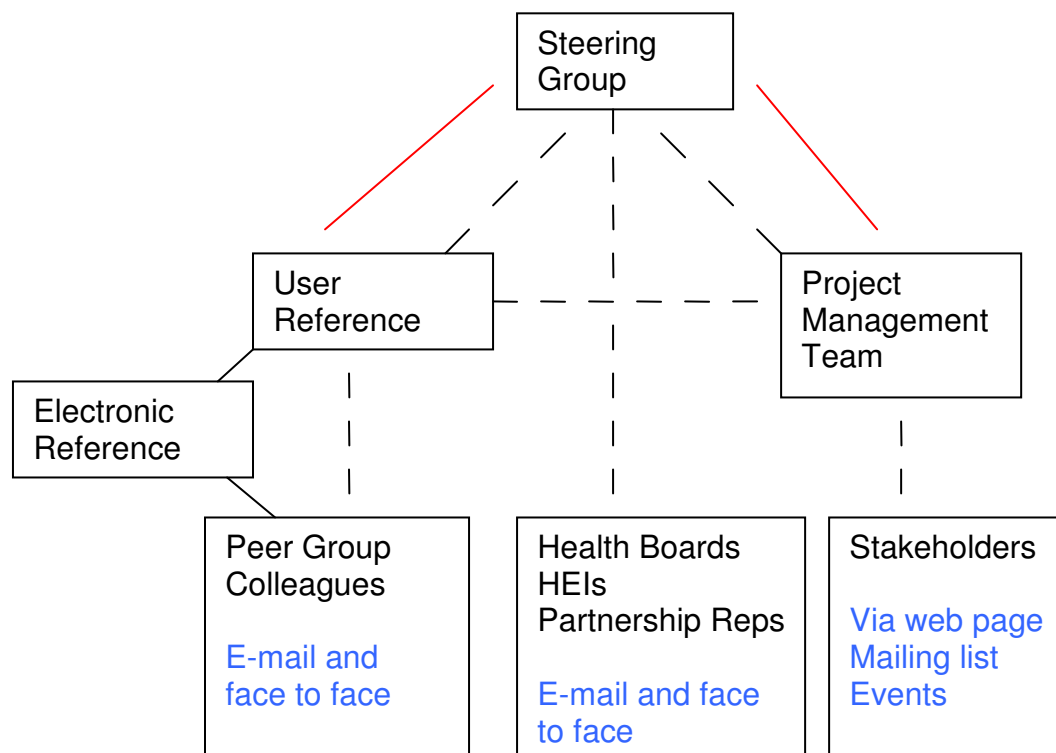
The Electronic Reference Group will consist of:
