







Seasonal Flu Vaccination Programme 2018-19: Vaccines

The vaccines that will centrally procured for the 2018-19 flu immunisation programme are set out in the table below. Some flu vaccines are restricted for use in particular age groups. The Summary of Product Characteristics (SPC) for individual products should always be referred to when ordering vaccines for particular patients.

The green book chapter on influenza (Chpt 19) contains detailed advice on the flu vaccine and associated contraindications, colleagues should ensure they are familiar with, and refer to, this before vaccinating patients.
