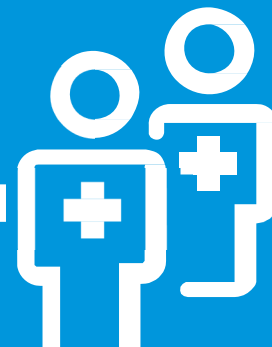


Primary Care Transformation Nurses working in Out of Hours in Scotland



NHS Education for Scotland invites nurses working in Out of Hours services to apply for funded courses provided via NES Portal and Practice Based Small Group Learning.

The courses have been developed to support General Practice Nurses and are also relevant to nurses working in Out of Hours services. Role development is in-line with Primary Care Transformation, the Chief Nursing Officer's Transforming Roles programme and the National Health and Social Care Workforce Plan Part 3 (Scottish Government, 2018). This enables nurses to work in integrated teams to meet the changing health and care needs of Scotland's population.

Criteria for access to courses

- be employed as a nurse working in general practice OR a nurse working in Out of Hours services in Scotland
- in the first instance please consider courses that commence before 31st March 2019 thereafter access our webpage for up to date information
