1.	<b>Deanery name</b>	NHS Education Scotland
2.	<b>Type of training post</b>	DCT1
3.	<b>Rotational Post information</b>	<p>Post 1 -Rotational</p> <p>September 2023 – March 2024 – Broxden Dental Centre, Perth: Public Dental Service (PDS, also referred to as the Community Dental Service)</p> <p>March 2024 – August 2024 – Dundee Dental Hospital, Dundee: Orthodontics, Emergency Dentistry, Paediatric Dentistry.</p>
4.	<b>Training unit/location/s</b>	This post is based in NHS Tayside as follows: Broxden Dental Centre PDS until March 2024 and a further six months will be at Dundee Dental Hospital (DDH) until Sept 2024.
5.	<b>Full address of training units where training will take place</b>	Broxden Dental Centre, Tweed Place, Perth PH1 1TJ. Plus additional PDS clinics within NHS Tayside Dundee Dental Hospital, Park Place, Dundee, DDH 4HR
6.	<b>Travelling commitment</b>	There will be a requirement to travel within the NHS Tayside board area in order to obtain a range of experience.
7.	<b>Educational Supervisor</b>	Will be confirmed with post-holder
8.	<b>Description of the training post</b>	<p>In this DCT post, you will undertake a range of PDS duties from September 2023 to March 2024. These may include dental inspection of schools, domiciliary care, care of patients who have special needs or require special care, and paediatric dentistry. There may also be opportunities to participate in GA lists. You will receive training in inhalation sedation.</p> <p>In DDH from March 2024 to Sept. 2024 you will have opportunities to gain experience in a mix of dental accident and emergency care, orthodontics, and paediatric dentistry.</p>
9.	<b>Primary Care training element</b>	In this post the DCT will work for six months in the PDS. You therefore need to be eligible for an NHS list number.
10.	<b>Educational programme summary and library facilities</b>	There is a Scotland-wide education programme for Dental Core Trainees which is designed to match the DCT curriculum. The programme has four themes running through each year of Dental Core Training. These are: Clinical, Communication, Career Development Skills and Quality Improvement & Patient Safety. Posts begin with a local health board and NES induction, followed by a number of face-to-face study events throughout the year, supported by Turas Learn. These events include all Dental Core Trainees in Scotland, as does the annual trainee conference. All trainees have access to study leave time (in line with terms and conditions of service) and budget. This may be used to access MFDS/MFD/MJDF courses and other courses linked to an agreed PDP. DCT posts include time for self-directed learning and trainees are encouraged to use this time for personal study and to complete quality improvement projects.
