8.	<b>Description of the training post</b>	This post is based in Edinburgh Dental Institute. This involves six months based in the Restorative Dentistry Department from September 2023 to March 2024. The post gives the opportunity for assessment and treatment of new patients allowing the post holder to gain wide, well supported, experience. In Restorative dentistry, there will be the opportunity to diagnose and treat a wide variety of patients including periodontal, prosthodontic and endodontic cases. Trainees may get an opportunity to be involved with the education of undergraduate Dental Hygienist-Therapists. Then there will be six months based in the Oral Surgery Department from March 2024 to September 2024, Oral Surgery gives the opportunity to perform a variety of surgical procedures, including extractions, biopsies and treatment of more complex conditions under LA, sedation and GA.

11.	<b>Educational programme summary and library facilities</b>	There is a Scotland-wide education programme for Dental Core Trainees which is designed to match the DCT curriculum. The programme has four themes running through each year of Dental Core Training. These are: Clinical, Communication, Career Development Skills, and Quality Improvement & Patient Safety. Posts begin with a local health board and NES induction, followed by a number of face-to-face study events throughout the year, supported by Turas Learn. These events include all Dental Core Trainees in Scotland, as does the annual trainee conference. All trainees have access to study leave time (in line with terms and conditions of service) and budget. This may be used to access MFDS/MFD/MJDF courses and other courses linked to an agreed PDP. DCT posts include time for self-directed learning and trainees are

		encouraged to use this time for personal study and to complete quality improvement projects.
